HAMILTON GALLERY


Hamilton Gallery was founded in 1957 with the Shaw Bequest, which consisted of approximately 800 items and £6,000 to provide for a building to house it. Herbert and May Shaw of 'Kiama' at Grassdale developed this beautiful collection which includes Asian and European ceramics, glass and silver, as well as objets d'art, paintings and prints.

In 1970 with the aid of a special grant from the Government of Victoria, 22 gouaches and 135 prints by Paul Sandby R.A. were purchased from Charles Gaussen of Gringegalgona.

Since then the Gallery has continued to grow to become one of the finest regional galleries in Australia. Supporting the Gallery is the Friends of Hamilton Art Gallery which recently celebrated 40 years of active fundraising and community engagement.
